- 1. I am a legal assistant at WeirFoulds LLP, lawyers for the Applicant, Rakuten Kobo Inc. ("**Kobo**"), and as such have knowledge of the matters herein deposed.
- 2. This affidavit is sworn in support of the motion brought by Kobo to continue the suspension of proceedings in its application pursuant to s. 106(2) of the Competition Act pending the determination of Kobo's application for leave to appeal a decision of the Federal Court of Appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada ("SCC").
- 3. At paragraph 2 of my original affidavit filed on this motion, I referred to the fact that Kobo's application for leave to appeal to the SCC was filed on August 13, 2015.
