REPLY TO RESPONSE BY CANADIAN REAL ESTATE ASSOCIATION TO MOTION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE BY THE NATIONAL FSBO NETWORK INC.

1. The National FSBO Network Inc. (NFN) submits this reply to the response by the Canadian Real Estate Association (CREA) to the NFN Motion to Intervene in this Application.

CREA's Response, para. 9

2. The NFN welcomes the support of the CREA for its Motion to Intervene, but submits that the condition attached, that the CREA be given "the right to documentary and oral discovery of the NFN", is not consistent with the role that the NFN would play in the proceedings and likely to lead only to delaying the progress of this application.

CREA's Response, para. 8

- 3. The NFN submits that in its response, the CREA accepts that the role that the NFN has requested to play in the proceedings would be limited to the following: "NFN seeks permission to 'submit written evidence to the Tribunal in regard to the role of FSBO businesses in the Canadian real estate market, the services provided, the fees for such services and further information in regard to market share.""
- 4. The NFN further submits that the written evidence it would provide on "the role of FSBO businesses in the Canadian real estate market" would be compiled by the NFN from publicly available data, that the Vice-President Operations at NFN would answer any questions on the content of the submission if required to do so by the tribunal and thus, "documentary and oral discovery of the NFN" by the CREA should not be made a condition for the granting of leave to intervene by the NFN.
- 5. The NFN submits that an oral hearing is unnecessary to deal with this motion.
