## NOTICE OF APPLICATION

TAKE NOTICE that the Commissioner of Competition (the "Commissioner") will make an

application to the Competition Tribunal, on a day and place to be determined by the

Competition Tribunal, pursuant to sections 92 and 104 of the Competition Act (the "Act")

for:

- 1. A Interim Order in the form of the Draft Interim Order exhibited to the affidavit of Denis Corriveau, filed, against the Respondents pursuant to section 104 of the *Act* requiring that the marketing of the Respondents' Vancouver port terminal services be held separately from each other and from the JV operator and management, by prohibiting joint marketing to third party non-integrated grain companies (those with no ownership interests in port grain terminals on the Canadian west coast) in the joint operation of the Respondents' Vancouver port terminals pending determination of the Commissioner's application for an order pursuant to section 92 of the *Act* (the "Application").
- 2. The grounds of the Application are:
  - (a) that the Commissioner has filed it's Application alleging that the proposed JV of SWP and JRI (the "proposed JV") will likely prevent or lessen competition substantially in the provision of port terminal grain handling services at Canadian west coast ports;
  - (b) that there is a serious issue to be decided by the Tribunal with respect to the anti-competitive effects of the proposed JV; that there will be irreparable harm if the parties are able to share sensitive commercial information and jointly market their port terminals; and that the balance of convenience favours granting the relief sought.

- 3. The Applicant relies on sections 10 and 104, of the *Act* and Rule 23 of the *Competition Tribunal Rules*.
- 4. The following documentary evidence will be presented:
  - (a) the affidavit of Denis Corriveau, sworn the  $10^{th}$  day of November, 2005; and
  - (b) such further and other material as counsel may advise.

The Applicant ask that this matter be heard in the English language.
