

1. I am the party referred to in the Order of the Competition Tribunal pronounced on



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

2. I have reached a satisfactory agreement ending any outstanding differences between myself and Chrysler Canada Ltd. and as part of this agreement, I have instructed my solicitors to consent to the issuance of an order in the form attached as Schedule "A" to this my affidavit.

I have agreed that I will not in the future assert in any legal proceedings that actions of Chrysler Canada Ltd. have substantially affected my business or precluded me from carrying on business within the meaning of section 75 of the Competition Act.
