ORDER

(Amendments to the Notice of Application)

[1] **FURTHER TO** the informal motion of the Commissioner of Competition by letter dated March 17, 2026, seeking leave to amend her Notice of Application to add Six Flags Entertainment Corporation as a respondent in the proceeding, following certain admissions made during discovery, in accordance with rule 104(1)(b) of the *Federal Courts Rules*, SOR/98-106;

[2] **AND CONSIDERING** that counsel to Canada's Wonderland Company confirmed that they will also act for Six Flags Entertainment Corporation and that they will accept service on its behalf;

[5] The informal motion of the Commissioner of Competition to amend her Notice of Application to add Six Flags Entertainment Corporation as a respondent in the proceeding is granted.

[6] The Commissioner shall serve and file her Amended Notice of Application by Wednesday, March 25, 2026.

[7] Canada's Wonderland Company and Six Flags Entertainment Corporation may serve and file an amended response by Wednesday, April 1, 2026.

[8] The Commissioner may serve and file an amended reply by Wednesday, April 8, 2026.
